**Student Ambassador Programme
(AML)**

Involvement of the Student Ambassadors

The student ambassadors will participate in this programme on a part-time basis and are expected to work on weekdays or weekends as needed. Their working schedule will be communicated in advance, taking into account operational requirements and the timing of campaigns and events. 02 Manager (Hong Kong Institute for Monetary and Financial Research)

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct rigorous and policy-relevant research on topics of interest to the AoF and the HKIMR, and report main research findings to both academic and non-academic audiences
- Contribute to the administration of the HKIMR, such as preparing meeting materials and liaising with the Institute's main stakeholders (e.g. Advisers, Directors, Visiting Scholars, etc.)
- Communicate with multiple parties with cross-discipline, and diverse research and technical backgrounds

Requirements

- Postgraduate degree in one or more of the following broad fields of specialisations: economics, finance, applied econometrics. A PhD degree (obtained or close to completion) and interest in empirical macroeconomics or finance is a definite advantage
- At least 3 years of experience in conducting academic research / thought leadership at central banks / universities / research institutes / international institutions
- Good analytical, programming and synthesis skills

- Good command of English, good drafting and presentation skills

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct independent research: advance dissertation research with the aim of producing a high-quality working paper
- Deliver a research seminar: present research to department staff toward the end of the fellowship programme
- Contribute to departmental work: participate in research discussions, and perform other projects as assigned

Requirements

- Ph.D. candidates in economics, finance or related fields
- Completed field exams and are in the dissertation stage of Ph.D., preferably in final year
- Excellent quantitative skills with experience in conducting research in relevant fields
- Good interpersonal skills and interest in conducting policy-relevant research
- Good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese

04 Director, Solutions Delivery (Tax Services)

Key Responsibilities

- Report to the Executive Director (ED) of Solution Delivery, support the Global Securities System (GSS) project, and serve as a subject matter expert for tax services and solutions

- Coordinate with internal and external stakeholders on system selection and delivery, serving as a key liaison between operations and IT teams to ensure smooth roll-out of new systems
- Work with the GSS project manager on end-to-end project management, including maintaining project timetables, monitoring key deliverables and project budgets, and producing progress reports
- Work with key stakeholders to develop the operating models for GSS asset servicing

Requirements

- University degree
- At least 8 years of relevant experience in the securities services industry, preferably acquired from market infrastructure providers or custodian banks
- Extensive experience in implementing tax servicing systems and solutions, including:
 - ◆ Withholding tax management
 - ◆ Tax reclamation
 - ◆ Regulatory compliance, assisting with tax documentation, such as W-8/W-9 forms, and compliance with regulations like FATCA and Qualified Intermediary (QI) agreements
- Experience in managing global tax servicing teams in a global asset servicing operations hub
- Experience in managing a sizeable team and a track record of delivering complex projects
- Familiarity with financial markets, preferably in both fixed income and equity products
- Well organised, detail-oriented with effective communication skills
- Strong problem-solving and analytical skills, and highly motivated with the ability to manage competing priorities and meet deadlines

- Good knowledge of cryptographic principles, security best practices, and smart contract vulnerabilities
- Experience in deployment of solution on public / private cloud
- Experience in using version control (Git) and agile development methodologies
- Proficiency in Solidity, Java, Go, or other blockchain-oriented languages
- Knowledge of using SWIFT in Custody Services is a plus
- Self-driven and a good team player
- Good analytical, interpersonal and communication skills
